Overview of PTC study

All students are given access to the Online Learning Environment (OLE) which contains the online PTC course materials, including online PTC notes and quizzes and feedback.

Students can Enrol and/or Subscribe to study. The differences between Enrolment and Subscription study are shown below. Either or both options can be chosen.

2020 Paper exam option

An online exam is included in every enrolment, however you are able to purchase a Paper exam if you prefer. There are two Paper exam windows options available during every 6 month enrolment.

2020 PTC Lecture Series option



Each year, four PTC units are taught as PTC lecture series at Moore College. This provides an opportunity for local students to learn from Moore College faculty.
